

Required Safety/Other Classes

Following are the safety and other required classes emphasized in the contract:

Boom Lift / Scissor Lift*	None	*Ivy Equipment (by appointment – see further instructions below)
Fork Lift*	None	*Ivy Equipment (by appointment – see further instructions below)

*Complete a class registration form and write "Boom Lift" or "Fork Lift" as the name of the class. Leave the Day and Time blank. Submit it to the Training Center. The Training Coordinator will review the request and mail you a pre-authorization voucher good for one class at Ivy Equipment.

The following classes are also required in order to qualify for the bonus:

Commercial painters – Confined Space and Hazmat

Industrial painters – Confined Space, Hazmat and Lead Refresher

April 1 Wage Increase	April 1 Bonus
Journeyman and Upgrade Painters will earn the annual wage increase if they are current in the required safety classes as of April 1. <i>Except for OSHA 10 retakes (allowed once per year), required safety classes do NOT count toward the bonus.</i>	Journeyman qualify for the April 1 bonus if they have <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • worked enough hours, • are current in required safety and other classes • AND earned 24 <i>elective</i> hours as of April 1.
Painter Upgrades can move up a level (and receive a wage increase) whenever they: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • are current in the required safety classes • AND earn 24 <i>elective</i> hours. <i>Required safety classes DO count toward upgrades.</i>	Painter Upgrades are not eligible for the annual bonus.
